

We had a beautiful interwar Kaunas tour and had a chance to hear the story of Kaunas.






We visited the museum of Čiurlionis, we saw a lot of paitings painted by him.

In Lithuania they have a traditional dish called cold beetroot soup. In Italy we don't usually eat cold soups.










Here they have big hallways and they have couches where you can sit between one lesson and another. In Italy we don't have couches and we only have one floor.

In Italian school there is only one floor, here we have four.


The cultures are very different but we can find a lot of similarities.
